We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 21 November 2013 and two copies of the above-referenced report. We have completed our review of this report and offer the following comments.

The report provides a thorough review of the known resources in and around the project area. While our office concurs that the project area has a lower probability of cultural resources based upon its topography and setting, we do not concur that that equates to no probability. Given a project of this size, our office would recommend that the entire area should be surveyed, although clearly significant segments would be considered lower probability and could be surveyed at a less intense interval. We are in agreement with the report regarding the identification of the areas of highest site probability.

We look forward to receiving two bound copies of the final report with the comments addressed as appropriate, along with a pdf of the report.
