We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 23, 2018 (received April 9) and two copies of the above referenced report. We have completed our review of this report and have the following comments to offer:

Please include the Lead Federal Agency and address on the Title Page. If there is no Federal involvement in the project, please state that the survey was performed as due diligence or in anticipation of Federal permitting/funding.

If the proposed project were to require state permits or federal permits, licenses, funds, loans, grants, or assistance for development, we would recommend to the federal or state agency or agencies that no further cultural resource survey or investigations are needed. If a federal agency becomes involved in a project on the property through providing funding or a permit/license, they may disagree with the level of effort and/or the conclusions and require further work. In addition, American Indian Tribes may also disagree and request further investigations.
