CSX Almonaster Site USACE Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination

Reference is made to your request, on behalf of CSX Transportation, Inc., for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (Corps) jurisdictional determination on property located in Section 12, Township 12 South, Range 12 East, Orleans Parish, Louisiana (enclosed map). Specifically, this property is identified as a ±79.5 acre site south of Almonaster Avenue located in New Orleans.

Based on review of recent maps, aerial photography, soils data, the delineation report provided with your request, and a site inspection conducted on December 5, 2023, we have determined that part of the property contains wetlands and non-wetland waters that may be subject to Corps' jurisdiction. The approximate limits of the wetlands and non-wetland waters are designated in red and blue, respectively, on the map. A Department of the Army (DA) permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act will be required prior to the deposition or redistribution of dredged or fill material into waters of the U.S.

The delineation included herein has been conducted to identify the location and extent of the aquatic resources for purposes of the Clean Water Act for the particular site identified in this request. This delineation may not be valid for the Wetland Conservation Provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985, as amended. If you or your tenant are USDA program participants, or anticipate participation in USDA programs, you should discuss the applicability of an NRCS Certified Wetland Determination with the local USDA service center, prior to starting work.

Please be advised that this property is in the Louisiana Coastal Zone and a Coastal Use Permit may be required prior to initiation of any activities on this site. You and your client are advised that this preliminary jurisdictional determination is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of this letter unless new information warrants revision prior to the expiration date.
