This is in response to your letter received August 25, 2016, concerning the above-referenced project. There were three known archaeological sites identified within the foot print of the project. 16PC91 and 16PC39 Loci A and B lacks integrity. 16PC39 Loci C and 16PC127 have been removed from the area of development. There are no significant archaeological resources located within the footprint of the proposed project. Therefore, the Office of Cultural Development (OCD) has no objection to the development of the property.

However, please be aware, that this documentation may provide only a baseline of information to a potential developer, as it does not fulfill the regulatory responsibilities to the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) or National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). If at the time of development, federal permits, licenses or monies are utilized, the Federal Agency or agent will need to submit an official NHPA Section 106 request to the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).
