RE: Water service to Port owned Land

Dear Robert:

Per your email on 6/04/10, please accept this as a response to your questions.

- 1. Natchitoches is interested in providing water service to the Port Facility and is capable of providing an additional 300,000 gallons per day above the existing usage.
- 2. The water treatment plant in Natchitoches has a daily capacity of 8 million gallons per day. Currently we are underway with a \$5 million expansion that is expected to increase our daily output capacity by 4 million gallons per day. This new expansion is expected to be in place by the end of 2011.
- 3. The feed line from the Grand-Ecore tank to the port is a 12" pvc line which extends onto the port property. This produces a static pressure of approximately 55 #.

The Water System in the area of the port is fed primarily from a 1 million gallon tank in East Natchitoches with in turns feeds a 300,000 gallon tank located on La Hwy. 6 East at Grand-Ecore.
