Dear Ms. Kerr:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 22 August 2019 and one copy of the above referenced report that was submitted as Due Diligence. This letter is for preliminary, informational purposes only and does not constitute consultation or agency coordination with our Office as defined in 36 CFR 800: "Protection of Historic Properties" or by any state regulatory process. The recommendation stated below could change once the responsible federal and/or state agency initiates consultation with our Office. Consultation with the State Historic Preservation Office is not a substitution for consultation with Tribal Historic Preservation Offices, other Native American tribes, local governments, or the public.

If the proposed project will require federal permits, licenses, funds, loans, grants, or assistance for development, we would recommend to the federal or state agency or agencies that no historic properties have been identified in the project area and no further cultural resource survey or investigation is needed. The State Historic Preservation Office will provide the above recommendation regarding historic properties and effects to them at this project location if a federal agency initiates consultation.
