On behalf of our client, Central Louisiana Economic Development Alliance (CLEDA), Eagle Environmental Services, Inc. (Eagle) respectfully requests a letter of concurrence regarding the following matter. Representatives of CLEDA have requested a cultural resources assessment for a piece of property in Avoyelles Parish, Louisiana. The subject site is approximately 700 acres in size.
