To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as verification of the Town of Olla's excess water and wastewater capacity.

Potable Water Capacity

The Town of Olla maintains three ground water wells with a total production capacity of 1.45 MGD. On average, the Town of Olla uses 0.25 MGD. Therefore, there is 1.22 MGD of potable water available as excess capacity.

Wastewater Treatment Capacity

The Town of Olla operates and maintains the wastewater treatment plant that serves the Olla Industrial Park. The total treatment capacity of the Town's wastewater system is 210,000 GPD. On average, the Town utilizes 102,000 GPD of the 210,000 GPD in available capacity. Therefore, there is 108,000 GPD available as excess capacity.
