1. MBL Holdings LLC is approximately 0.742 miles East Southeast of the subject property and is listed in the DEL SHWS database. The facility began operating under a closure plan with DEQ in April 1990 and in 2001, it determined the facility met the requirements and requested for monitoring wells to permanently be plugged and abandoned. The EDR report states that the facility received an NFA notice in December 2001 but it cannot be found in EDMS. In 2010, they received an NOD notice for a couple compliance issues were citated during inspection for failure to update contact name on the HW-1 form, an unlabeled hazardous waste drum and an open hazardous waste drum but these issues were corrected and closed during inspection. In September 2019, the facility submitted its bankruptcy payment to DEQ.

-A review of the report provided by EDR listed no unmapped sites within the MSD.

-A review of the EDR Radius Map and SONRIS Interactive Maps indicated one plugged and abandoned rig supply well (Well ID: 031-8549Z) West of the subject property.

-The SONRIS Interactive Maps indicated one oil/gas well owned by DeSoto Parish Police Jury (Well Serial Num: 65676) on the subject property that was plugged in May 1957 and two oil/gas wells actvie and pumping gas owned by HA RA SUL; DeSoto Police Jury just West of the subject property (Well Serial Num: 239711 and 239668).

-NPMS indicates no pipelines on the subject property.

-Based on this information, it is unlikely any recognized environmental conditions are associated with the site.
