If the proposed project were to require federal permits, licenses, funds, loans, grants, or assistance for development, we would recommend to the federal or state agency or agencies that sites 16SL229, 16SL230, and 16SL231 are not eligible for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places, and that no historic properties have been identified in the Certification Boundary area. We do not recommend additional cultural resources survey or investigation.
